Only those persons who have made representations seeking to change the Deposit LDP (Objectors), whose representations were duly made, have the right to appear before and be heard by the Planning Inspector(s) at the examination(Section 64 (6) of the 2004 Act).

Notice will be given before the opening of the examination. The format of the hearings will be determined by the appointed Planning Inspector(s). Any queries relating to the examination can be directed to the Programme Officer (contact details will be made available on the Council's website).
